A BILL

To amend the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act to require reporting regarding clean energy demonstration projects, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Clean Energy Dem-*
5 *onstration Transparency Act of 2023”.*

6 **SEC. 2. PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND OVERSIGHT REPORT-**
7 **ING REQUIREMENTS.**

8 *Subsection (h) of section 41201 of the Infrastructure*
9 *Investment and Jobs Act (42 U.S.C. 18861) is amended by*
10 *adding at the end following new paragraph:*

11 *“(3) FURTHER REPORTS.—*

12 *“(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than six*
13 *months after the date of the enactment of this*
14 *paragraph and at least semiannually thereafter,*
15 *the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on*
16 *Science, Space, and Technology and the Com-*
17 *mittee on Appropriations of the House of Rep-*
18 *resentatives and the Committee on Energy and*
19 *Natural Resources and the Committee on Appro-*
20 *priations of the Senate a report, and make pub-*
21 *licly available in digital online format, that con-*
22 *tains, for the period covered by each such report,*
23 *for each covered project or other demonstration*
24 *project administered or supported by the pro-*
25 *gram, the following:*

1 “(i) A copy of any initial contracts or
2 financial assistance agreements executed be-
3 tween the Department and an award recipi-
4 ent, including any related documentation,
5 as the Secretary determines appropriate.

6 “(ii) A list of any material, technical,
7 or financial milestones that have or have
8 not been met.

9 “(iii) Any material modifications to
10 the scope, schedule, funding profile (includ-
11 ing cost-share requirements), project part-
12 ners or participating entities, or budget of
13 the project.

14 “(B) STREAMLINING.—To the extent prac-
15 ticable, the Secretary may synchronize the re-
16 ports required under subparagraph (A) with
17 other required reports, such as those required
18 under—

19 “(i) paragraph (1); and

20 “(ii) section 9005(e) of the Energy Act
21 of 2020 (42 U.S.C. 7256c(e); enacted as di-
22 vision Z of the Consolidated Appropriations
23 Act, 2021).”.

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
