OFFERED BY MR. BOWMAN OF NEW YORK

AND MR. NORCROSS OF NEW JERSEY

Page 2, after line 14, insert the following:

1 (b) OUTREACH.—The Director shall conduct pro-
2 gram outreach to recruit fellowship applicants—

3 (1) from all regions of the country;

4 (2) from historically underrepresented popu-
5 lations in the fields of science, technology, engineer-
6 ing, and mathematics; and

7 (3) who graduate from or intend to carry out
8 research at a variety of types of institutions of high-
9 er education, including—

10 (A) Historically Black Colleges and Uni-
11 versities;

12 (B) Hispanic-Serving Institutions;

13 (C) Tribal Colleges and Universities; and

14 (D) institutions of higher education that
15 are not among the top 50 institutions in annual
16 Federal funding for research.

17 (c) SPECIAL CONSIDERATION.—The Director shall
18 give special consideration to an application from an indi-
19 vidual who graduated from or is intending to carry out

1 research at an institution of the type listed in subsection
2 (b)(3).

Page 2, line 15, redesignate subsection (b) as sub-
section (d).
