

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. \_\_\_\_\_  
OFFERED BY MR. POSEY OF FLORIDA**

Add at the end of title III the following:

1 **SEC. 3 \_\_\_\_ . RESTRICTION ON FEDERAL FUNDS RELATING**  
2 **TO CERTAIN CHINESE SPACE AND SCI-**  
3 **ENTIFIC ACTIVITIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—No Federal funds authorized in  
5 this Act may be obligated or expended for the following:

6 (1) For the National Aeronautics and Space  
7 Administration (NASA), the Office of Science and  
8 Technology Policy (OSTP), or the National Space  
9 Council (NSC) to develop, design, plan, promulgate,  
10 implement, or execute a bilateral policy, program,  
11 order, or contract of any kind to participate, collabo-  
12 rate, or coordinate bilaterally in any way with China  
13 or any Chinese-owned company unless such activities  
14 are specifically authorized by a law enacted after the  
15 date of the enactment of this Act.

16 (2) To effectuate the hosting of official Chinese  
17 visitors at facilities belonging to or utilized by  
18 NASA.

1 (b) EXCEPTION.—The restrictions described in sub-  
2 section (a) shall not apply to activities with respect to  
3 which NASA, OSTP, or NSC, after consultation with the  
4 Federal Bureau of Investigation, have certified—

5 (1) pose no risk of resulting in the transfer of  
6 technology, data, or other information with national  
7 security or economic security implications to China  
8 or a Chinese-owned company; and

9 (2) will not involve knowing interactions with  
10 officials who have been determined by the United  
11 States to have direct involvement with violations of  
12 human rights.

13 (c) SUBMISSION.—Any certification made under sub-  
14 section (b) shall be submitted to the Committee on  
15 Science, Space, and Technology and the Committee on Ap-  
16 propriations of the House of Representatives, the Com-  
17 mittee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation and the  
18 Committee on Appropriations of the Senate, and the Fed-  
19 eral Bureau of Investigation, not later than 30 days prior  
20 to the activity in question. Any such certification shall in-  
21 clude a description of the purpose of such activity, its  
22 agenda, its major participants, and its location and tim-  
23 ing.
