## 1 SEC. 205. INFORMAL STEM EDUCATION.

2 (a) GRANTS.—The Director of the National Science

(b) USES OF FUNDS.—Activities supported by grants
under this section may encompass a single STEM discipline, multiple STEM disciplines, or integrative STEM
initiatives and shall include—
